Launching of the VII International Video Contest of the CGU

The Compostela Group of Universities (CGU) launches the VII International Video Contest, a competition that awards the audiovisual talent and creativity of CGU students.

The videos submitted for competition can be made by a student or a group of students of CGU member universities, in this case one of them will be designated as the official representative. The story of the video must relate to at least one of the topics for 2018's edition: Camino de Santiago, European identity and culture, and values of solidarity in Higher Education.

Besides, the videos must be original creations and comply with technical requirements specified in the [guidelines for VII International Video Contest](#).

Prizes

For this edition, the first prize is up to 1000 euros and the second 400 euros. The winners will also receive a diploma certifying the prize obtained. For more details, visit [CGU's website](#).

May 2018: Publication of the decision of the jury.

September 2018: Official presentation of the winning videos at the annual CGU General Assembly.

Tourism Organization (UNWTO) and Helsinki España – Human Dimension (HE).

The aim of the forum is to analyse and study Human Rights and their reflection on the Camino de Santiago, as well as to consider the relation between the Camino and Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs).

More than a 100 students and academics from over 20 universities will be selected to participate.
